

## Communication and Language

We will be reading lots of stories about different types of transport and using the structure of the stories to help our sentence building.

We will continue asking 'how' and 'why' questions to find out more information.

Opportunities to develop communication and listening and attention skills will take place daily, as well as vocabulary development.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be looking at building relationships throughout our school day and in our PSHE lessons, considering what makes a good friend and how we need to listen to one another. We will learn about different beliefs and celebrations and how these make us unique and special.

## Physical Development

We will be doing obstacle activities in PE to develop our coordination and teamwork.

Our fine motor skills will be developed using activities such as writing, scissor skills, tweezer tasks, threading and playdough. We will be having a strong focus on letter formation.

## Literacy

We will be consolidating our knowledge of Phase 2 and 3 Phonics, focusing on blending CVC words to develop fluency in our reading.

We will use our phonic knowledge to read and write sentences that include known sounds and common exception words. We will use 'The Jolly Postman' to inspire our letter writing.

Using Talk for Writing, we will be learning the story 'Whatever Next' and creating our own stories using the story format.

## Mathematics

This term we will be focusing on the language of adding and taking away, starting to write number sentences.

We will also extend our learning to numbers beyond 10, focusing on numbers up to 20.

We will explore different methods of manipulating, composing and decomposing shapes.

## Understanding the World

We will be using transport to explore similarities and differences between the UK and other countries.

We will be looking at features of our local environment and looking at maps.

We will also be investigating the features of space.

## Expressive Arts and Design

We will be looking at art through movement and creating our own artwork using Vincent Van Gogh as our inspiration.

We will be designing, creating and evaluating different modes of transport using junk modelling.

## RE

We will be looking at the 'Ends of the Earth' topic in our RE lessons.

We will be learning about the Catholic Social Teachings of Stewardship and Call to Community, thinking about how we can care for the communities we are part of.
