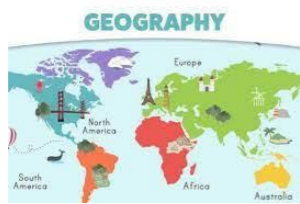


Geography

Prayers, Saints and Feasts and Advent

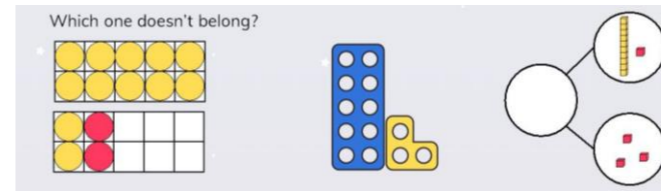
The children will recognise why we pray and think about how saints help us get to know God. In Advent the children will be learning about the preparation of Jesus.



Maths

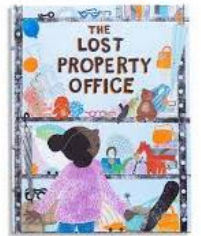
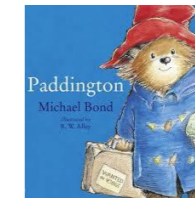
Addition and Subtraction

We will be looking at addition and subtraction this term. We will be using part-whole models, number lines and tens frames to help us in our learning.



English

The class will be looking at nouns, verbs and adverbs as well as using capital letters for names of people, places, days of the week and months of the year.

Computing

Digital writing.

Children will start typing words into documents, building sentences on PowerPoint, and presenting on railways. We will also explore finding pictures on a safe child's website such as Kiddle and use copy and paste.



PSHE

The children will be exploring personal qualities, strategies to manage feelings, the impact of sleep and relaxation on wellbeing, the importance of hand washing and sun protection, identifying and dealing with allergic reactions, people in the community who keep us healthy
