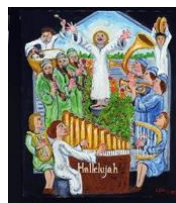


Geography

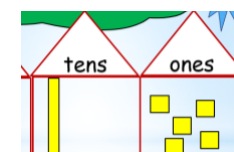
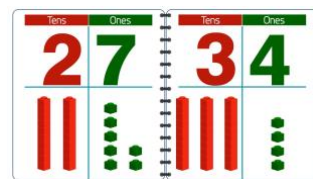

We will be looking at addition fact families and looking at part whole models.

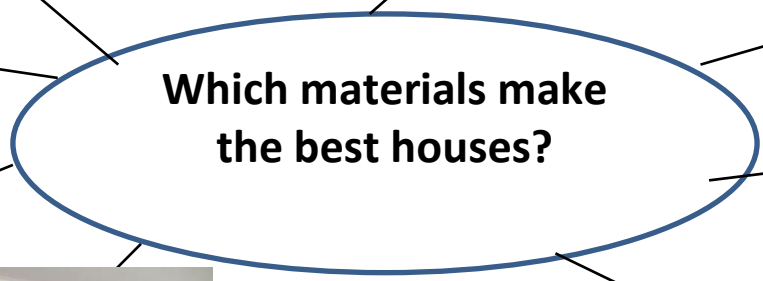
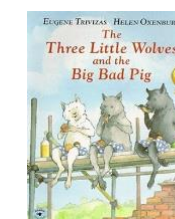


English
